

## **Tuesday, May 19, 2020**

Have your child check Mrs. Johnson's Weebly page for Music/Art today.

### Language Arts

Poetry/Word Work – What is a Book? Write the poem on a piece of paper to post somewhere that the children can read daily to practice their fluency and expression.

Daily Reading Comprehension booklet – pg.69 Read through once and then have the children go back with a marker to find the best answers to the 4 questions.

Writing - Have the children pick a journal writing activity from one of the writing menus sent home in Learning Package #1 or write something of their choice. They can look in their writing folder for ideas if they like as well. It is probably a good idea to keep the various writing menus in their folder to make them easier to find, as we will be doing daily choice writing now. Completed writing on one side of the folder and writing they aren't finished on the other side. They may want to work on some pieces over a period of time. They can write whatever they like and then will choose which final (best writing) piece to send to me before June 12. Let them pick the one that they are the proudest of.

### Math

Problem of the Day – You and your mom go to the theme park every year. Last year, you spent \$48 on an adult ticket and \$32 on a child ticket. This year, you spent \$55 on an adult ticket and \$37 on a child ticket. How much more money did you and your mom spend on tickets this year from last year?

Collecting and Representing Data– Watch the 3 videos about graphs posted on the Weebly math page. They may work through the booklet at their own pace over the next few weeks and we will be looking at it together on Google Hangout.

### Religion
